Overview:	Student Outcomes:
Objectives	Students will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop a paragraph summarizing their findings on a disaster. • Synthesize their findings into short statements. • Create an Animoto video showing the main elements of a disaster.
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Four to six sentence edited paragraph • Four to six synthesized statements • Computer • Headset • Animoto student account
Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Using Titanic paragraph, show students how to synthesize each sentence. <u>Product:</u> 4-6 statements under 50 characters. 2. Using image.google.com show students how to use advance search engine to locate usable images (not hindered by license agreements). Topic: frog 3. Activity: Students choose an animal and then do three searches: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Content Type (any, clip art, line drawings) • Color • Labeled for reuse <u>Product:</u> Find 10 – 20 “usable” pictures that represent the 4-6 statements. 4. Demonstrate video creation using Animoto and Titanic.
