

# **Glogster**

## **Step-by-Step Directions**

1. Type in [www.glogster.com](http://www.glogster.com)
2. Either Login if you already have an account using your user name and password or “Sign Up” if you do not have an account. Once signed up you will be sent an email to confirm your account. This could take a good 5-10 minutes so be patient.
3. Go into your email account, click on the link and you will be directed Your Dashboard on the Glogster website.
4. Click on Post New Glog then select either portrait or landscape format, then click on Post New Glog. This takes a minute or two – you will see the clock running telling you the percentage downloaded.
5. If you want to see more or less of the Glog you are creating, click on “View” in the tool bar at the top of your screen.
6. You now can add text, graphics, image, wall (background), audio and video by clicking on the various options as shown below.
7. I like to start out with “Wall” to set my background image which everything else will sit on top of. You can easily choose one from the Gallery or upload a picture by clicking on My Images. Once you choose a background, click on “Use It” and it will be loaded to your Glog.
8. Next you can add images by clicking on the “Images” tab. You can add images by uploading your own, or clicking on and going into Facebook, Flickr, Picasa or Google. Again, once you have chosen the image(s) you want, click on “Use It.”
9. Now you can add Graphics from the Graphics tab. Just drag and drop the graphics you want on to your Glog. You can rotate, enlarge, or decrease, the image using the built in handles.
10. Click on the Text tab then Gallery to choose from a large selection of text boxes which you can, again, just drag and drop onto your Glog. Click on the text box to open an array of options to use with both your text and the “box” it is in.
11. You can always reopen the tabs again by clicking on “ADD CONTENT.”
12. Lastly, you have the option to add audio and video to your Glog. You will need to select audio from one of your pre-recorded audio files. With video you have a choice of uploading your own pre-recorded video or choose one through Google, YouTube or Vimeo.
13. When you are finished, you can SAVE to your Dashboard and SHARE it with others through links to other programs.

# Voki

## Step-by-Step Directions

1. Type in [www.Voki.com](http://www.Voki.com)
2. Either Login if you already have an account using your user name and password or “Register” if you do not have an account. You will get a message that tells you to check your email for a confirmation link.
3. Go into your email account, click on the link and you will be directed Voki.
4. Click on Create a New Voki.
5. You first need to select an image for your anime so click on the head. Click on male, female or all, then scroll through the categories which are digimon, dogs, cats, classic, toons, anime, animals, edgy, oddballs, random, VIP, politics, or holiday. You will have different types of options based on the category you choose.
6. Click on the image you like and it will appear in the box on the left. Now the fun part starts – you have tons of choices on how to customize your anime and background. Different animes have different options to choose from. You can change the hair, mouth, clothing, and bling by clicking on each of those categories. There is also the opportunity to TWEEK the size and color of these categories by using options located below your anime.
7. When you are finished, click on “Done.”
8. Now you can click on Background and Players to choose from the many options listed there.
9. Finally, you will make a recording. The options are to record over the phone, text to voice, using a microphone, or uploading a pre-recorded message. You will have up to 60 seconds for your recording.
10. When you are finished, click on Publish. It will save your Voki to your account and give you the option to Email your Voki or publish it to your Wiki, Blog, Site, etc.
